PASIN DELIVERS FUNDING FOR RIVERLAND TOURISM PLAN 2030

The Riverland community is set to benefit with Tony Pasin delivering funding under Round 3 of the Federal Liberal and Nationals Government's highly successful Building Better Regions Fund.

Federal Member for Barker Tony Pasin said the Liberal and Nationals Government's investment in local projects under Round 3 will help grow the economy and build a strong future for Australia's regions.

Included in successful applicants of round 3 is \$20,000 for Destination Riverland to develop a strategic plan towards 2030 that will build on the success of the Riverland Tourism Plan 2020 and identify further opportunities to maximise visitation and economic yield.
